# Maintaining Boundaries in a Digital Age Online Training on Ethical Boundaries in Ministry

The prevalence of electronic communication and social media raises new ethical challenges for church leaders today.

Maintaining Boundaries in a Digital Age explores issues of clergy ethics and responsibility in an era of instantaneous, electronic communication. It builds on the first course in the Keeping Our Sacred Trust series, Understanding Clergy Sexual Ethics, which is a primer on preventing clergy sexual misconduct.

Maintaining Boundaries in a Digital Age considers new risks and concerns related to sexual ethics in the rapidly changing landscape of electronic media and social media, such online pornography, internet relationships, and questionable behavior on social media. It also addresses the risks and the opportunities in using electronic communication as a ministry tool.

**Maintaining Boundaries in a Digital Age** addresses real concerns and questions from the perspective of those in pastoral ministry:

- Why are boundaries important to effective ministry?
- How is self-care critical to maintaining appropriate boundaries?
- When is it appropriate to use different forms of social and electronic media?
- How can privacy be maintained?
- Why are clergy particularly at risk for pornography use?
- How can clergy escape the lure of pornography?
